- Welcome:** The Chair, Cllr Mountain introduced himself, welcomed everyone and explained the purpose of the APM.

- Chair's Report and Thanks:** Cllr Mountain read his report noting specific points. Looking ahead, the next 12 months are expected to be positive, with any new buildings falling under the parish councils responsibility to ensure they are designed in keeping with the character of the village. - District Councillor's Report:** Cllr Langdon-Morris read his report, focusing on Framlingham resilience and Recovery Working Group in relation to the more infrastructure, housing and solar power that are proposed. Praised the Be Well bus for being a positive initiative that's made a difference to the community. There was an update on devolution and progress toward the establishment of unitary councils. Contact was welcomed regarding small funding opportunities available through his ECB budget. Discussed tree protection and the effects of second home premiums.
