

For an easy circular walk around Badingham, start at the Village Hall (3 miles, 1hr 15m).
Parking at the Village Hall or along Low Street.

Village Hall, Low Street, Badingham IP13 8JS [//forgiven.possibly.crescendo](#)

1. Walk up the footpath at the rear of the Village Hall car park
2. Turn right onto Old Rectory Road, pass in front of the elegant Old Rectory. This was for a number of years the East Anglian Academy for Transcendental Meditation.
3. After the Old Rectory turn left onto a footpath
4. Follow this path along the field margin, round to the left and downhill passing Brick Kiln Farm
5. Below the farm turn right onto the bridlepath past Plains Farm, continuing along a grass track
6. Go through a small gate into the field and not far along take the path to the left, passing through a gap in the hedge, then through a second field and past the barn of Twin Oak Farm
7. Turn right onto the drive to reach Mill Road, and turn left
8. At the left hand bend in the road, follow the footpath straight ahead
9. The path continues round two sides of a field and leads to St John the Baptist church, go through the churchyard and down to the road, stopping to buy a book in the church porch bookshop (proceeds to the roof appeal)
10. Turn left and walk down Low Street, passing the café on the left (open Weds and Thurs 10.30-12.30) and continue back to the Village Hall
